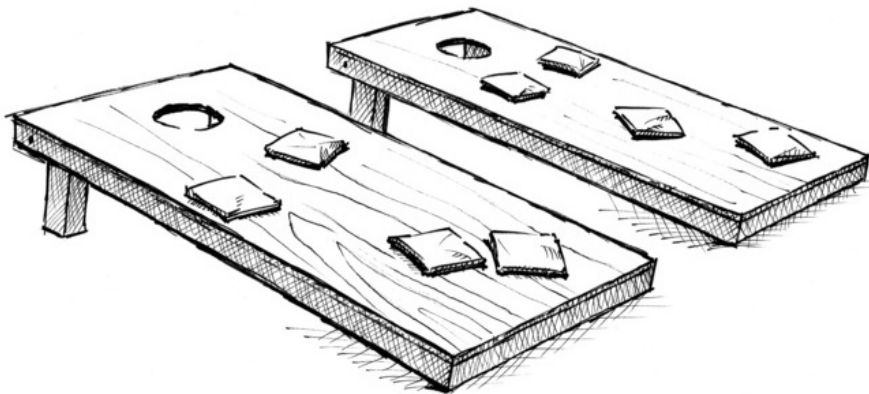

PLAYING EQUIPMENT

- (2) cornhole boards
- (2) 4-bag sets of all-weather, resin-filled bean bags in opposing colors
- A swimming pool

GAME SETUP

Unfold legs and place cornhole boards at opposite ends of the swimming pool. (On the edge, not *in* the pool.)

GAME PLAY

Players make their tosses from the water using all-weather, resin-filled bags. If you're good enough, your bags won't get too wet!

SCORING

For traditional Cornhole:

- **3 points** – Each bag that goes completely through the hole or any bag accidentally pushed through the hole by an opponent's toss.
- **1 point** – Each bag sitting completely on the board, hanging into the hole, or hanging off the edge of the board but *not* touching the ground.
- **0 points** – Bags hanging off the edge of the board and touching the ground or bags resting on a bag already on the ground.

Awarding Points:

Add up the points scored by each player at the end of each round. The higher-scoring player is awarded the *difference* between their points and the lower-scoring player's points. If players' points are equal, they cancel each other out and no points are awarded to either team for that round.

Example 1: One player scores 5 points and the other scores 3 points. The higher-scoring player's team is awarded 2 points and they throw first in the next round.

Example 2: Both players score 3 points. No points are awarded and the team who went first in the previous round throws first again.
