PLAYING EQUIPMENT

- (1) cornhole board
- (2) bean bags in opposing colors (or more)

GAME SETUP

Unfold legs and place the cornhole board on a flat surface.

GAME PLAY

Players begin by establishing the order of turns. Player 1 explains the toss (for example, from a certain position and/or in a particular way), and attempts to make his toss through the hole as he described. If Player 1 is successful, every subsequent player attempts the same toss in exactly the same way. If a player's toss fails to make it through the hole, he acquires an 'H.' After all players have made their attempt, Player 2 explains *his* toss and attempts it. The others attempt his toss in the order of their turn. If the player calling the toss misses the hole, control of the toss moves to the next player.

P-I-G ("Pig") may be played if a shorter game is desired or when there are a large number of players.

SCORING

Players are eliminated when they've missed 5 tosses, acquiring all the letters in the word "Horse." The last player still in the game is the winner.
